Week 27: Trusting God in Hard Times

Scripture Reading:

"But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus." - Philippians 4:19

Opening Prayer:

Open by asking God to help your family understand and trust in His provision, especially during times of financial uncertainty.

Devotional:
