Week 3: Trusting in God's Timing

Scripture Reading: "To every thing there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven." - Ecclesiastes 3:1

Opening Prayer: Initiate with a prayer to cultivate patience and trust in God's impeccable timing.

Devotional:

In our fast-paced world, waiting can be one of the hardest things to do. Yet, often, God calls us to wait, reminding us that His timing is perfect. The seasons of our lives, whether filled with joy, challenges, growth, or rest, all have a purpose in His grand design. Discussion:

1. Why can trusting in God's timing be challenging? (Psalm 27:14)

How can we cultivate a heart that trusts in God's timing, even when it's difficult? (Isaiah 40:31)

Activity:

As a family, discuss and list events where you felt God's timing was evident. Reflect on the lessons learned from those times.

Closing Prayer:

Wrap up by thanking God for His perfect plans and seeking patience as you wait upon His timing.
